Dear FOC Church Family,

It is hard to believe that I moved into my house about a year ago! In some ways it feels like yesterday, but in other ways it feels like a long time ago. We still have a few boxes to unpack, a few pictures and decorations to hang, a few touches to add. I suspect it will take years!

If you have ever bought a house, much less built one, you know that you do a "gripe sheet" where you enumerate the imperfections and issues that need to be adjusted. It might be minor like a paint touch up, or it could be more significant, like a missing fixture. The hope is that the builder will agree and fix the issue.

I wonder what God thinks when he moves into the house that is our heart? Does He look at all of our imperfections, write them down, and confront us? Is there a sticky window jam of our heart? Is the door hinge of our prayer life rusty? Has our front door of hospitality got a lock that just won't open?

God is not fooled when He comes into our house/heart. He sees the sin, and yet He does not recoil. Instead, He gives us a NEW house/heart. Rather than "gripe" about all the issues, He simply removes them from the equation. He burns it down! He makes it new!

Jesus is the house/heart where we live. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come". ~ 2 Corinthians 5:17. This verse means that our house/heart is a TRUE place where not only God can live — but also where we can have peace and comfort in a way that transforms us! I know I am thankful to have a place to live. A place where I can relax; a place where I can be with my family; a place where I can hang my hat. Isn't it great to know that your house/heart is that place for our Lord?

This drive is a congregation-wide opportunity to collect baby items for Life Network's pregnancy center in Colorado Springs. Over the past year, this wonderful organization has saved 259 babies, inspired 86 decisions for Christ, and influenced 89% of their ultrasound patients to choose life! We'll have a table available in the Worship Center for you to drop off donations. **Items Needed:** baby shampoo, baby wash, baby lotion, baby food (fruit and veggies), baby cereal, bottles, bottle brushes, burp cloths, children's Bibles, 6 month – 2T clothing, crib sheets, diaper bags, diaper rash cream, diapers (sizes 3-5), milk-based formula, Gentlease or Parent's choice (purple), hair brushes, nail clippers, newborn clothes, nipple cream, nursing pads, onesies, outlet covers, pacifiers, preemie clothes, pull-ups, sippy cups, sleep sacks, socks, teething rings, temporal thermometers, towels with hoods for babies and toddlers, toys 0-36 months, washcloths, and "what to expect when you're expecting" books. Upcoming Stephen Minister Training

Based on the fact that the several people interested in becoming Stephen Ministers had too many conflicting job-related and/or family-related issues to come up with an acceptable training schedule, we most likely will NOT have another class this fall/early-winter.

However, we do plan on offering classes for 2021, in late-winter/spring and/or perhaps summer/fall. In the meantime, we encourage anyone who occasionally hears a persistent tiny voice suggesting you have the *Heart to Make a Difference* with our many "hurting-but-silent" FOC members (or even "hurting" Community Friends) to contact our Stephen Ministers for more about what you can expect in the training.

Continuing Education Opportunities

More importantly, we'll share the positive impact we can have helping others. Of course, those tiny voices can also mean you are losing your mind [wry smile] OR it might be the Holy Spirit encouraging you to take a Leap of Faith to help others seeking God's cure for their diverse "hurts."

Additionally, we hope many of you will join us in our Stephen Ministry-required Continuing Education classes as we strive to provide you tools to get through the Thanksgiving and Christmas Holidays, which can be very difficult times for people in "pain." For example, on Sunday, October 11, I will lead a discussion based on the book *Don't Sing Songs to a Heavy Heart*; while on November 8, Tami New will discuss *The Art of Listening*; and on December 13, Andrea will address using our "Holiday Caring Toolbox." Our current plan is to start after Late Service, 11:30 am, and devote 90-120 minutes on each topic, depending on class participation.

Finally, are asking for YOUR input & interest in classes and their sequencing for 2021! Here are the Eleven topics for your consideration and voting:

We intend to provide these topics sequentially at 2021's monthly sessions, based on voting results. Of course, if you would like to see/participate in sessions with different topics, please let us know, and we will make every effort to address them once we get feedback from the congregation, Pastor Moreno, and the Elders to ensure there is wider interest in those "new" topics. "Perfect Vision 20/20 - All Eyes on Him"
Hebrews 12:1-2

Our Purpose: We are a community that is committed to challenge and raise up men to be warriors and disciplers for Christ — for our families (our marriages and children), as single men, in the workplace, and in our "community" with others in this world.

What are your values? – In his message this past Sunday, Jeremy said your values will push you out of your comfort zone. When you truly value someone or something, you are willing to go out of your comfort zone for that person. Think of the significant people in your life: that you value: parent, spouse, son, daughter, grandparent, or perhaps a friend. How do your actions translate to their value in your life? Do you value them in a way their behavioral style relates to or in their love language?

What are other values you hold? Here is an exercise for you:

Step 1: Write a list of your values.

Step 2: Separate that list into your "A" group and your "B" group.

Step 3: Take your "A" group and narrow it down to your top 8 values.

Step 4: Take those 8 and narrow it down to 5. Just for fun, narrow that 5 down to the top 3, and if you had to pick your #1 value, what would it be?

I (Tom Keithley) have a set of leadership value cards if you would ever like to do this exercise utilizing these cards. Have fun with this, and then see how your daily agenda reflects your values.

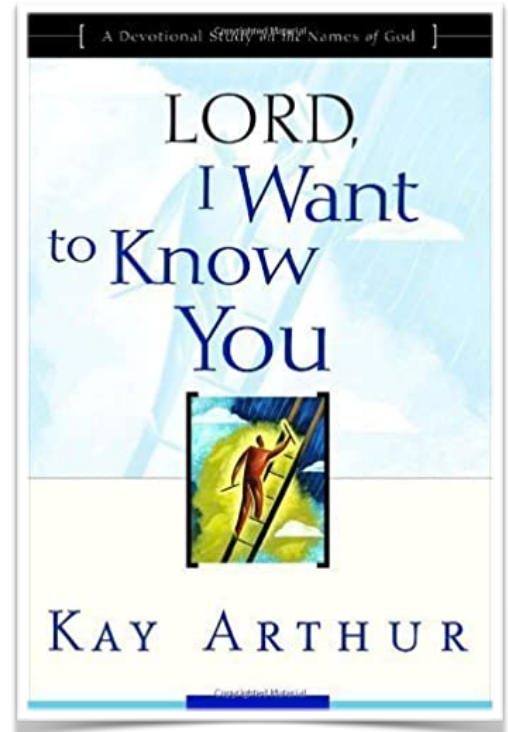
JEWELS Tuesday Morning Women's Bible Study
